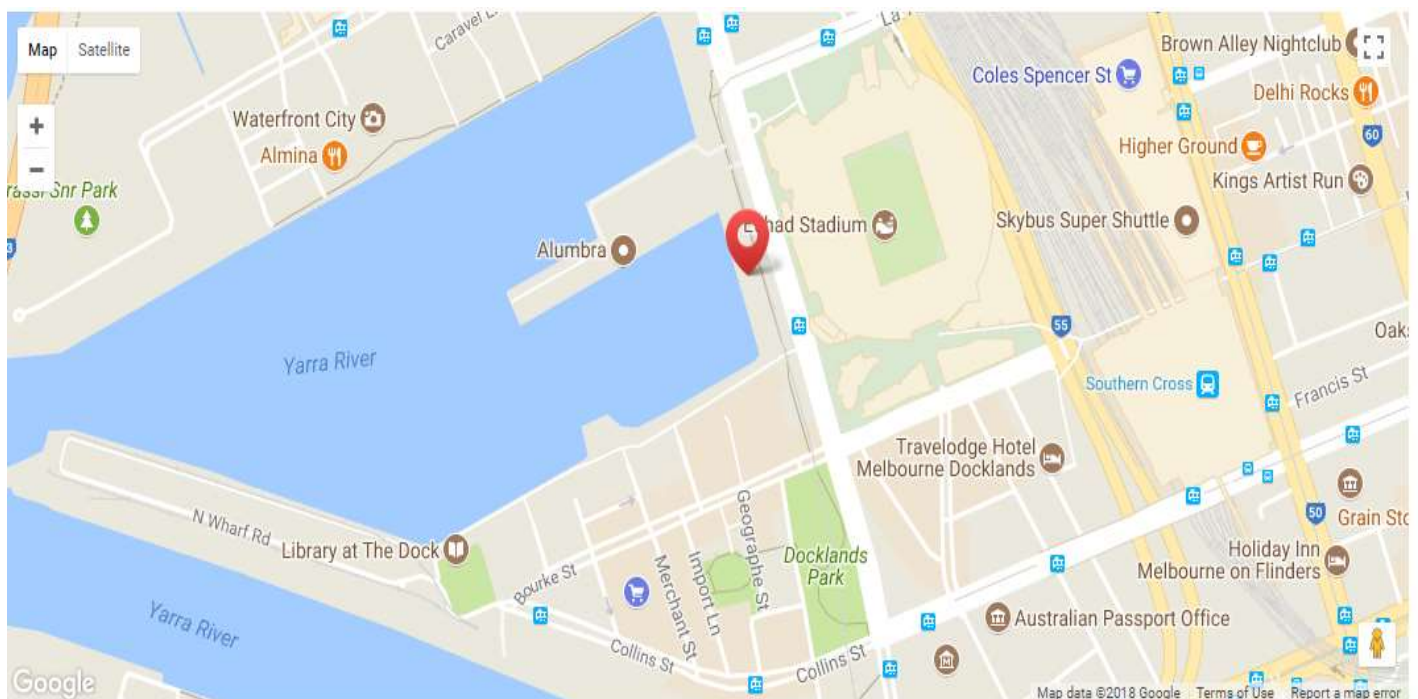
Getting to Docklands

- Port Phillip Ferries berth at Docklands, Victoria Harbour Promenade. Directly across the street from Etihad Stadium.
- Trams: Take the 35, 70 or 75 tram to Stop D3 Etihad Stadium/Bourke Street Docklands. The dock is right across the road.
- Train: Get to Southern Cross station and take the Northern exit. Walk towards Etihad Stadium and take the stairs down to the left to reach Harbour Esplanade, Docklands. You will see the dock across the road. You should allow approx. 5 – 10 minutes to walk from Southern Cross.
